The end of the digestive tract where feces (poo) leaves the body

A sac that holds the urine (pee) made by the kidneys

The operation to remove the foreskin of the penis

Discharge or release of semen from the penis

A coiled tube at the back of the testicles that holds sperm

When the penis fills with blood and becomes hard

The extra skin at the tip of the penis

The tube-like sex organ located outside of the body

The gland near the bladder that adds fluid to sperm

Sac that holds the testicles

A combination of sperm and fluid. This is what leaves the penis during ejaculation

Two small glands that make fluid that gives sperm energy to help them move

The reproductive lifegiving cell for a person with a penis

Glands that make sperm and the hormone testosterone

Urine (pee) and semen move through this tube to the outside of the body

Two narrow tubes that carry sperm from the testicles to the urethra
