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Hello Chris,

I have today completed our request to be added to the "Settlement Boundry Review".I also added comments on the comment form.

Please let me know if anything else is required to have our land considered for other proposed uses. Our small parcel of Agricultural Land surrounded by land used for other purposes could cause conflict. When the city of Niagara Falls allowed the 31 acres of agricultural land to the North of us to be used for a commercial purpose, it effected our land use. Currently we are using our land to produce field crops (34 acres) along with fields in the surrounding area, but as land prices increase and less property is available in the immediate area (due to land use change) we make change our farming operation. Agricultural uses like raising livestock, grain-storage and drying operations cause sound and odour issues.

We feel it is important for the region to consider these factors as they expand the Settlement Boundaries. It is only fair that as surrounding land use is being changed, neighbouring properties are also considered.
