**NOTICE TO RESIDENTS**

**CONTRACT NO. 2021-T-63  
REHABILITATION OF REGIONAL ROAD 27 (SCHISLER ROAD) STRUCTURE NO. 027230  
REHABILITATION IN THE CITY OF NIAGARA FALLS**

Please be advised that The Regional Municipality of Niagara (The Region) will be rehabilitating the Regional Road 27 (Schisler Road) bridge (Structure No. 027230) over the Canadian Pacific Railway under Contract No. 2021-T-63

The Niagara Region has declared the Regional Road 27 (Schisler Road) rehabilitation project as an essential project. Work is proceeding under this declaration. The contractor will be required to provide a Covid-19 Health and Safety Policy for completing this work under current recommended guidelines. This includes social distancing both with other crew members and the public who may approach the job site. We respectfully request that this social distancing be reciprocated by the public towards the crew members on site. Notifications will be delivered as required to front doors and interaction will be avoided unless circumstances dictate that verbal notification is required. In those instances, social distancing of at least 2.0m will be maintained

This contract will be carried out on behalf of the Region by Urbanlink. Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin on September 15, 2021 (Contractor maybe currently mobilizing and prepping site) and will be continuous until completion, likely mid-December, weather permitting.

Every effort will be made to maintain access to abutting properties and to minimize inconvenience to businesses, residents and pedestrians. The Region's construction inspector will be Mr. Kyle Vanhell (Associated Engineering Ltd.), cell phone 289-241-3166. Mr. Van Hell will be present at all times and can be contacted for information or to identify concerns.

Periodically, there will be some inconvenience to you during the construction period. Due to the scope of work involved, driveway access may be affected. Every effort will be made to give you advance notice should this occur. Staff from Niagara Region or Region appointed staff will be contacting you to discuss details of your driveway entrance.

In order to protect construction workers and complete the work safely and cost effectively, a single lane closure will be required for the duration of the project and traffic will be unavoidably congested at times. Although the contractor is required to provide safe pedestrian access at all times, care is requested when walking through the construction zone.
